BIBLE

Learning about God, his love, faithfulness, and miracles is fun and easy with our Bible Curriculum. Children learn how to apply God's word to their lives. They memorize scripture verses, and learn about stories in the Bible that will stick with them for as long as they can remember.

LANGUAGE ARTS

Under this category students learn Phonics, Reading, and Writing. With the Phonics Curriculum we teach your children to blend words, rhyming words, syllables, and much more. They will read multiple books on their own, in small group settings, and with the class. Students will perfect writing in print. They will write sentences and paragraphs on their own. They will learn spelling words with a new list each week. Your 1st Grader will study Poetry and literary devices. Your student will learn to identify parts of a book such as the title page, the table of contents and the glossary. Your student will perfect print and cursive writing. Your child will learn over 160 phonograms to unlock their full reading potential.

MATH

We make learning math fun for all students! Students learn to solve story problems, algebraic equations, determine the greater and lesser value, learn to measure and compare measurements in inches, centimeters, feet, and yards, they will practice skip counting to lay a firm foundation for multiplication and division, and much more.

SCIENCE & SOCIAL STUDIES

We take students on a trip around the world learning about different Countries. They learn about Community helpers with poster visuals and activities that keep them engaged. Your student will learn the 50 US states and study early Presidents and their impact on our nation.
