BIBLE

Learning about God, his love, faithfulness, and miracles is fun and easy with our Bible Curriculum. Children learn how to apply God's word to their lives. They memorize scripture verses, and learn about stories in the Bible that will stick with them for as long as they can remember.

LANGUAGE ARTS

Third grade language solidifies students to the basics of capitalization, punctuation, parts of speech. Word usage, writing skills, etc. Language class begins with an oral review of language skills and concepts including identifying parts of speech, applying punctuation rules, and determining sentence structure. New concepts are then introduced and taught in class, followed by a teacher-directed application of those skills and completion of the work text page together.

MATH

Arithmetic 3 presents concepts in an orderly manner, building on prior learning and including consistent year-long review. During class instruction, students will hear a thorough explanation of each concept and see procedures demonstrated step by step by the teacher. Concepts include long multiplication and division, memorizing multiplication facts, reducing fractions. Application to real-life situations and daily thinking questions stretch the students' reasoning abilities.

SCIENCE & SOCIAL STUDIES

Our History book is an exciting text, challenging third-grade students with the patriotism and Christian Character that served as cornerstones in the founding of our great nation. Students will learn about people who have helped to build America, including inventors, influential women, scientists, evangelists, presidents, and many more.
